




## **Flash Flood Watch**

Wednesday, September 19, 2018



A Flash Flood Watch is in effect for all of southeastern Arizona, including the Tohono O'odham Nation, today, Wednesday, September 19, 2018 from 11 AM to 11 PM.

A very wet atmosphere is in place across southeastern Arizona. Numerous showers and scattered thunderstorms will develop later this morning and continue into tonight. Heavy rain is likely with strong showers and thunderstorms with rainfall amount ranging from 0.75" to 2.50".



Do You Really Know How Deep the Water is?

**Do NOT** drive through running washes or other bodies of running water:

6 inches of fast-moving water can knock over and carry away an adult.

**12 inches** of fast-moving water can carry away a small car.

**18-24 inches** of fast-moving water can carry away most large SUVs, vans and trucks.
