FREE FACE MASKS

It is important that every individual do their part to prevent the spread of COVID-19, this includes individuals wearing a cloth face mask when in public places, washing hands frequently, and maintaining physical distance from others.

The Arizona Department of Health Services is partnering with Hanes to provide free face masks to Arizona's most vulnerable populations. Individuals who fall within the vulnerable populations or those who may not be able to purchase a mask can place an order for 5 reusable cloth face masks. There is a limit of one order per household.

Vulnerable populations include:

- Elderly (65 years and older)
- People who live a nursing home or long-term care facility
- People with underlying medical conditions
- Pregnant Women
