PROHIBITED:

- Door to Door trick-or-treating
- Trunk-or-Treats
- Gatherings to pass out candy
- Costume parties
- Indoor haunted house
- Crowded Hayrides
- Fall Festivals
- Any social gatherings

RECOMMENDED ALTERNATIVE:

- ✓ Pumpkin carving & decorating with members of the household
- ✓ Decorating your home
- **✓ Virtual Costume Contests**
- Movie night with household members
- ✓ Scary story night with household members or virtually with others

OTHER FUN ALTERNATIVES:

- ✓ Zip line Candy bags to kids of your family members, instead of going to your door steps
- ✓ Candy Shoot, send candy bags down a shoot from your door steps, to kids of your family members
- ✓ Have the kids dress up and household members pass out candy through their house windows/doors, have the kids go window/door to window/door say Trick or treat, and the guardian will have them candy thru the window to their own kids... doing this until their candies are depleted.
- √ No-contact candy bag drop-off for kids at their homes
- ✓ Easter egg hunt but for candy, in their yards or house when it gets dark
