COVID-19 Vaccinations available to Tohono O'odham Nation High-Risk groups

Emergency Use Authorization has been approved for the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine. As supply allows, the vaccine will be made available in phases based on the CDC guidelines and Arizona Department of Health Services priority system for high-risk groups. Vaccination is now available to persons in the Tohono O'odham Nation including:

- **All persons aged 75 years and older.**
- Frontline essential workers in the Tohono O'odham Nation.
- Healthcare professionals, medicine men and women, First Responders, Police, Fire
- Government workers: District Leaders, Legislative, Executive, and Judicial Branches
- Health Transportation
- Information Technology/Cyber Security
- Utility workers: ex: TOUA, Water/wastewater, Waste removal services
- Educators, school workers, support staff, and child care workers
- Emergency Management
- Food producers, Grocers, and fuel (such as Bashas', Shell, gas stations)
- Health and Human Services (Child Welfare, Adult Protective Services, Behavioral Services, Family Assistance, Community Health, HOPP, Senior Services)
- Tucson Indian Center
- IHS Area Office
- Other essential agencies identified by the Tohono O'odham Nation
- Residents and staff of long-term care facilities (AHSSNF will vaccinate this group)

Dates: December 30th, December 31. More clinics will be scheduled.

Times:

- Appointments 8am-3:30pm.
- Walk-ins allowed until 2pm. Walk-ins must meet the criteria above of 75 years and older or frontline essential workers in the Tohono O'odham Nation.
