COVID-19 Vaccine Available at TONHC for ALL Adult Tribal Members

Newly Expanded Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be 18 years or older
- Members of the Tohono O'odham Nation (TON) or other American Indian/Alaska Native Tribes *regardless of employment status or medical diagnoses*
- Non-Native Essential Workers who work on or with the Tohono O'odham Nation
- **NEW: Non-Native persons who reside in a household with a member of a tribe**
- **NEW: Non-Native persons who reside on the Tohono O'odham Nation**

We encourage persons at increased risk for severe disease from COVID-19 to be vaccinated as soon as possible. High risk groups include:

- Serious health conditions: diabetes, obesity, cancer, chronic kidney disease, lung disease, heart disease, transplants, immune system conditions, Down syndrome, sickle cell, smoking
- Pregnancy and breast feeding
- Persons in group/conjugate/crowded living conditions

Helpful Tips for your Vaccine Visit:

- Wear a mask to cover your nose and mouth.
- Make sure you eat a snack and drink water prior to your vaccine visit.
- Wear a short sleeve shirt under your coat.
- ***Tribal Members: Please bring your photo ID, Tribal ID preferred but not required.***
- ***Non-native essential workers please bring your Employee ID or a letter from your supervisor stating your name, employer, and occupation.***
- ***Non-native household members/residents of TON please bring proof of residence.***
- Bring your insurance card. Vaccine is free.
- Dress for the weather.
- Be prepared to stay 15-30 minutes after vaccination.

If you feel ill or you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms:

- Please do NOT come to be vaccinated.
- Please call TONHC at one of the numbers listed above and schedule a COVID-19 Test.

If you have had a previous COVID-19 vaccine:

- TONHC has Moderna Vaccine. If you have previously received a different brand of COVID-19 vaccine outside of TONHC, it is recommended that you receive that same brand for Dose #2.

If you have been diagnosed with COVID-19:

- Please wait at least 10 days before coming for a vaccination to avoid infecting others.
- ***We have medical providers on-site to help answer questions about the vaccine***
