

COVID-19 VACCINATION UPDATE Please Distribute Widely San Simon Health Center Now Offering Vaccine Appointments

TONHC continues to give COVID-19 immunizations as vaccine doses arrive to our facilities. We are now scheduling appointments for COVID-19 vaccination for Phase 1A and Phase 1B (see below to check if you are in these groups). COVID-19 vaccine requires 2 doses. The ideal timing for Dose #2 is 28-35 days after Dose #1. Please tell the schedulers if you need to schedule your 1st or 2nd dose.

San Simon Health Center is now offering a limited number of vaccines each week, by appointment only.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: COVID-19 Vaccine supply is still limited. At this time, TONHC can offer vaccine to:

- Members of the Tohono O'odham Nation and other tribes in the Phase 1A and Phase 1B eligible groups listed below. Note: for essential workers who are tribal members their place of employment can be on or off the Tohono O'odham Nation.
- Persons who are not tribal members who either work or live on the Tohono O'odham Nation, AND fall into one of the eligible groups below.

Phase 1A and Phase 1B eligible groups are as follows:

- Members of the Tohono O'odham Nation and other tribes, age 55 years and older
- Healthcare professionals, medicine men and women, First Responders, Police, Fire
- Essential Government Workers: District, Legislative, Executive, and Judicial employees who have been identified as essential
- Health Transportation
- Information Technology/Cyber Security
- Utility workers: TOUA, Water/wastewater, Waste removal services
- Educators, school workers, support staff, and child care workers
- Emergency Management
- Food producers, Grocers, Fuel (ex: Basha's, Shell)
- Health and Human Services (ex: Child Welfare, Adult Protective Services, Behavioral Services Family Assistance, Community Health, HOPP, Senior Services)
- Tucson Indian Center
- IHS Area Office
- Residents and staff of long-term care facilities
- TO Nation Executive Branch Gaming Office

If you do not currently qualify for Phase 1A or 1B, we ask that you wait to make an appointment for vaccination once you meet criteria.

Helpful Tips for your Vaccine Visit:

- Wear a mask to cover your nose and mouth.
- Wear a short sleeve shirt under your coat. Dress for the weather.
- Bring your photo ID, tribal ID, Employee ID as appropriate.
- Essential workers please bring a letter from your supervisor stating essential status if you do not clearly belong to one of the specific groups mentioned above.
- Bring your insurance card to your visit. Vaccine is free.
- If you feel ill or you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms on the day of your vaccine appointment, please do NOT come to be vaccinated. Please call TONHC at one of the scheduling lines listed above and schedule a COVID-19 Test.
